Town residents in Westminster are encouraged to take advantage of free weekly curbside pickup of all recyclable waste materials. Almost all packaging materials and containers can be recycled, and State law prohibits dumping of these materials into the waste stream as trash.

Call the above 800 number to find out which day of the week your street receives pickup service.

When filling recycling bins, make sure items are clean, although sorting of paper, glass, metal and plastic is no longer necessary. A "single stream" method of processing is now being used for curbside pickup ONLY. Any container, bin or box may be used at curbside but should be labeled as "Recycle" -- the WasteManagement trucks also pick up trash for paying customers so container should be clearly identified.

If you take recyclables to the town's transfer station, items must still be sorted. The drop-off center hours are as follows:
