When filling recycling bins, make sure items are clean, although sorting of paper, glass, metal and plastic is no longer necessary. = A "single stream" method of processing is now being used for curb= side pickup ONLY. Any container, bin or box may be used at curbside but should be labeled as "Recycle" -- the WasteManagement trucks also pick up trash for paying customers so container should be clear= ly identified.
